


2. Where were most of the Loyalists located in the colonies?




3. Which side did the Native Americans support in the war?

4. How many African Americans served in the war?




5. At the start of the war, for how long did men enlist in the army?

11. Describe the pamphlet series known as "The American Crisis":




"The American Crisis" was a series of articles written by Thomas Paine

They crossed the Delaware River and did a surprise attack on the British and Hessians at Trenton



Washington and his troops won

He and his troops often stopped to celebrate along the way


